⇒ INSTRUCTIONS FOR OWNERSHIP ⇐

- **MULTIPLE OWNERS:** Ownerships require separate and complete signatures. Joint ownerships must be recorded using "and" or the word "or" form of ownership.
- **OWNERSHIP CHANGE:** Any change in the form of an ownership of a horse that has already been recorded (in that ownership) will constitute an additional transfer and require payment of a transfer fee.
- **FEES:** Consult a current fee schedule for applicable transfer fees. If a contract sale involved, the "beginning date of contract" will be used as the recorded transfer date. The "ending date of contract" will be used to determine the applicable transfer fee. The post-mark will be used for dating purposes in determining the transfer fee.

*** CASTRATION***

If your stallion was castrated, complete this section and return this certificate to IPAR. Upon receipt, a new certificate, showing the horse as a gelding, will be issued to the recorded owner.
